Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>Generally the students are admitted to the courses as per rules and regulation of the Solapur University and Government of Maharashtra. Most of the students come from Solapur district and few from other. After admission, advanced and slow learners are identified from the merit and interaction with students. The extra coaching is arranged for slow learners under the guidance of mentors from the beginning. The student-teacher ratio is satisfactory maintained in the college. Teaching methods like experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving are followed. Almost all teachers in addition, use ICT for effective teaching/learning process. Language laboratory is used for teaching language and communication skills. The library is well provided with internet facility to the students and also has electronic data on various topics. There is a microphotography facility in the department. Students are using audio-visual aids for better understanding based on pedagogy. Teachers & students are allowed to argument with respect to pros & cons of concepts as well as research findings. Average percentage of full time teachers against sanctioned posts during the last five years is satisfactory. Students are evaluated at college level (CA) and university level (UA). Reforms are continuously done in this process. Internal assessment is transparent and robust in terms of frequency and variety. Mechanism to deal with examination related grievances is transparent, time-bound and efficient at both college and university level. Attainment of program outcomes, program specific outcomes and course outcomes are evaluated by the institution continuously.</p>
